



DISTINGUISHED STUDENT LEADERS PROGRAM

National Student Council's Distinguished Student Leaders program is a rigorous national skill- and knowledge-based recognition program that challenges students to dive deeper into the characteristics of leadership and to examine their own leadership styles and knowledge.

NatStuCo Distinguished Student Leaders demonstrate their leadership abilities by creating a personal leadership portfolio that shows they've met the award criteria in areas such as leadership, goal setting, decision making, time management, civic engagement, and more. This portfolio serves as a valuable record of their achievements and commitment as a leader—something they may refer to often when they're applying for college and scholarships. The program encourages your students to grow into exemplary role models and gives them the hard-earned recognition that they deserve.

The time it takes to complete these activities varies by individual—some students may be able to go from start to finish in a couple of



months. For others, the process may take one or two semesters to complete. No matter the timeframe, all applicants must participate in an assessment meeting with their advisers and principals to verify their completion of the requirements. The last step is forwarding the student portfolios to the national office for review. It can take up to four weeks for the national office to render a decision, and portfolios must be reviewed prior to the student's graduation.

The National Council of Excellence (NCOE) recognition is a prestigious national award program for middle level and high school student councils that maintain strong year-round programs and work to improve their schools and communities through their leadership activities. To earn NCOE recognition, student councils must present evidence of meeting the required indicators. Building this portfolio helps your council

identify its strengths and areas of growth, as well as providing the opportunity for national recognition.

Councils that go above and beyond the basic indicators can earn recognition as a National Gold Council of Excellence.
